## One-Day Grain Grading Workshop for Corn, Sorghum & Wheat Grain Handlers & Producers

To help grain handlers in recognizing features of grain that affect its grade, the Texas AgriLife Extension Service will hold a one-day workshop at the Texas AgriLife Research and Extension Center in Amarillo. The workshop will be offered on May 3rd and repeated on May 4th and will run from 9:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The workshop will provide current grain grading standards as well as basic hands-on training in grain grading of corn, sorghum and wheat. Participants are eligible to receive six CCA credits in Crop Management.

The grain grading workshops are being co-sponsored by the Panhandle Grain and Feed Association, Texas Cattle Feeders Association and the Texas AgriLife Extension Service. The workshops are being held as a pre-conference to the Panhandle Grain and Feed Association annual meeting. Registration is open to anyone interested in grain grading.

The cost of the one-day workshop is \$65.00 per participant. Pre-registration is required since registration will be limited to 60 participants per day.
