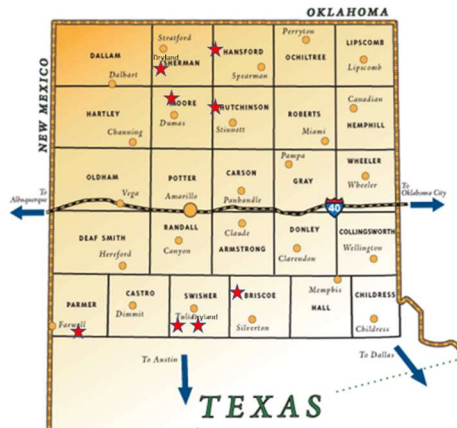


2021 Northern Texas High Plains/Texas Panhandle AgriLife Extension RACE Trials (Replicated Agronomic Cotton Evaluation)

Eight (8) Northern Texas High Plains RACE Trials are planned to evaluate early and early-medium maturity varieties:

- Briscoe - Dryland
- Hansford - Irrigated
- Hutchinson – Irrigated
- Moore – Irrigated
- Parmer - Irrigated
- Sherman – Dryland
- Swisher – Irrigated
- Swisher - Dryland



The same variety set will be evaluated in each water regime: irrigated (5) or dryland (3). Each seed company may enter 4 varieties per water regime. If a variety is entered in the irrigated trials, the same variety must be entered for all irrigated locations unless the producer has an herbicide technology request. A different variety set may be entered in the dryland trials.

Varieties must contain Glyphosate and Glufosinate resistance. All entries should contain a seed treatment such as Aeris or Avicta Complete Pak. We attempt to place trials in fields where producers will only be spraying glyphosate or glufosinate. Minimum plot size is 8 rows by 600 feet, but larger plots are planted with some cooperators due to the use of round-bale harvesting equipment. Dryland trials are larger. All varieties are replicated three times at each location. Because plot size and planting populations vary across locations, **6** bags of seed are requested for the irrigated locations, and **5** bags of seed are requested for the dryland locations. This will also provide enough seed in the event an additional location is added. Plots will be managed by the producers and harvested according to the producer harvest schedule. Grab samples from each plot are ginned at the Texas A&M AgriLife Research gin at Lubbock. Depending on harvest and ginning schedules, the 2021 variety trial report is anticipated to be available in February 2022.

The entry fee is set at \$325/entry/location for the 2021 season.
